Every visitor has a chance to win a perennial lavender plant for their own garden.

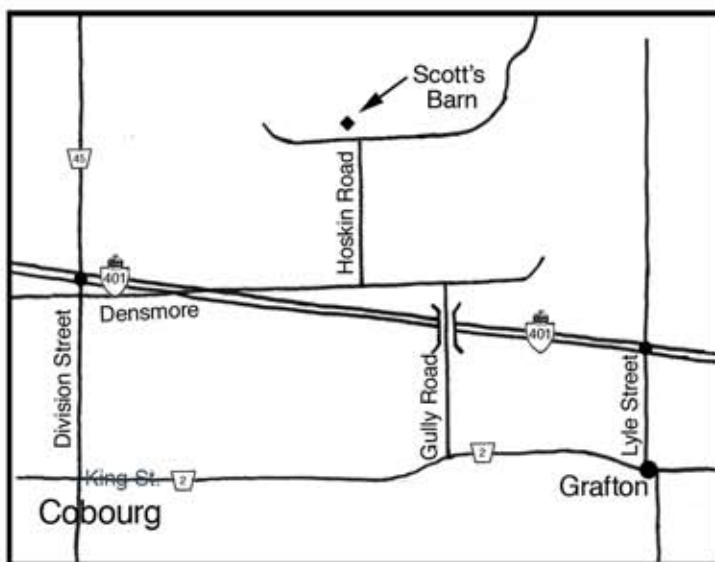
How to find us:

From the West:

Exit the 401 at Cobourg Division Street/Highway 45
Turn left (South) on Division Street and follow to the first traffic light, Densmore Road.
Turn left (East) onto Densmore and follow this road for about 9 kilometres/9 minutes.
This road will cross over the 401, and shortly after, turn at the second left (North) onto Hoskin Road.
After 2.6 kms you will reach a T intersection, turn left and Scott's Farm will be the first driveway on the right.

From the East:

Exit the 401 at Exit #487 Lyle Street/Grafton
Turn left (South) to County Road 2.
Turn right (West)travelling 2.3 kms to Gully Road.
Turn right (North) onto Gully Road.
Immediately after crossing over the 401, turn left at the intersection and travel .5 km to Hoskin Road.
Turn right (North) onto Hoskin Road.
After 2.6 kms you will reach a T intersection, turn left and Scott's Farm will be the first driveway on the right.
