### WATERCOLOUR

June 14th and 15th **Absolute Beginner's Watercolour with Martha Robinson**

### MOSAIC

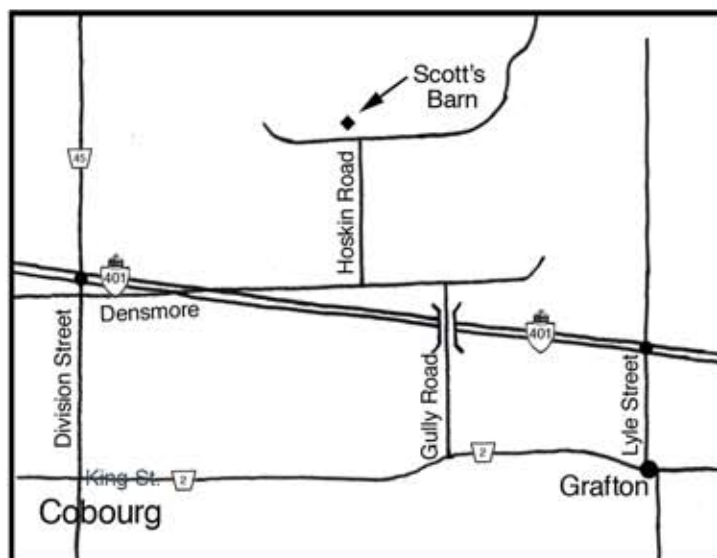
July 26th & 27th **Mosaic Table for Beginners**
